WHAT IS CARE?

The Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE) is a supplemental component of EOPS that specifically assists students who are single parents or heads of household receiving cash aid through CalWORKs/TANF. CARE offers supportive services, so students can acquire the education, training, and marketable skills needed to transition from public assistance to employment and self-sufficiency.

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

- Meet all the requirements and be admitted to the EOPS Program
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Be a single-parent / head of household
- Must currently be receiving TANF/CalWORKS cash aid for yourself or any dependent children

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

(in addition to EOPS responsibilities)

- Attend Mandatory orientation and workshops
- Comply with EOPS and CARE contract

SERVICES OFFERED

(in addition to services provided to EOPS students)

- CARE Grants (additional requirements)
- Gift cards (food and gas)
- Motivational & Informational Workshops
- Family-centered holiday events
- Single parent conferences
- Agency and County Referrals
- Scholarship opportunities
