We continue to project cash levels to be low in June after our second TRAN payment. Low cash levels continue to be a concern into July until deferral payments are received and later in the summer with the uncertain timing of signing the 2011-12 state budget. Therefore, we plan to issue another TRAN in July 2011.

Our 2011-12 Tentative Budget is based on the Governor's January budget best case scenario, which projects \$5 million in cuts for LBCC. We have approved a reduction in force and are continuing to negotiate reductions in health insurance costs to address these cuts.
