We expect cash levels to be low in June. We issued Mid-Year TRANs for \$10 million, but they must be repaid in June. With deferrals continuing to increase and the uncertain timing of signing the 2011-12 state budget, cash levels may be low in June and subsequent months. Therefore, we plan to issue TRANs for 2011-12 as well.

The Govenor's January budget projects a minimum of \$5 Million in cuts for LBCC for 2011-12. We are working with employee groups and taking other actions to reduce spending in response to the cuts in state revenue.
